Sunlight Ski Patrol has 54 active volunteer patrollers. Our relationship with area management and the paid patrol staff remains strong. We had over 1000 volunteer patroller work days during the '09-'10 season. Volunteer patrollers also serve to augment the paid weekday patrol staff on holidays, spring break and upon request.

As a patrol, we continue to raise funds, in partnership with the Sunlight Winter Sports Club, through our annual *Great Ski Swap*. Our OEC refresher was held on the 3rd weekend of September and well received by all who attended, and we had an *On-Hill* refresher on the second weekend of November, which covering lift evacuation, knots, radio procedures, and a First Aid Room walk-through and area management concerns.

Sunlight had a booming recruitment year, welcoming two transfers, one new auxiliary and eight new patrollers. Along with our new members, we also provided OEC training for Garfield County Search and Rescue volunteers.

The patrol held a Level I Avalanche class, a Level I MTR Class, two Sr. S&T clinics and one Sr. S&T evaluation during the 2009-2010 season. We look forward to another great season in 2010-2011.
